2.	 Higher Edge Promise Update CA Promise Innovation Grant Jumpstart, spring pilot The Promise Innovation Grant application has been submitted and we will find out the results February 10th. Some of the funds will go toward salaries to provide support for the JumpStart program. Transportation will also use some of the funds for the buses to be used. A big portion of approx. \$400k will go toward Data and Evaluation. The JumpStart Program was reviewed. Partners asked to know what would be done this spring. April is the goal to launch a small amount of JumpStart programs. The work of the JumpStart Program fits very well into the GCCCD strategic plan. A lot of the efforts with JumpStart is outreach work.
