1. Summer 2014 Calendar – attached
 - BUS/TRAN holds placed on Monday, July 14th
 - Grades finalized by Wednesday, August 6th

2. Fall 2014 Calendar – attached
 - At what time should open reg begin? 7, 7:30 or 8 a.m.? This time has varied over the past couple of years. If the start time is 7, there are phone calls to offices not yet open; if the start time is 8, there are phone calls about not being able to register. What time works best? Once we decide, I can add the time (along with the date) to the message that displays on WebAdvisor which may help with communicating with our students. We could also include the date and time in the email that we send to the known “open reg” group when we calculate priority registration appointments. So I’m asking 3 questions:
 - What time should open reg begin? (we still need to make this decision)
 - Should we include date and time on WebAdvisor? (we can still add the time to WebAdvisor)
 - Should we include date and time in the email to the open reg students? (too late for this term)
 - High School and Middle College Non-Residents – should they be charged non-resident and/or enrollment fees? (rates were modified for High School non-residents; we need to decide about Middle College high school students)
 - Non-resident tuition rates are now \$193/unit plus the \$46/unit enrollment fee

3. Spring 2015 Calendar – attached
 - Possible changes for Spring registration include:
 - FYE/FA and Athletes (need discussion on who, how to identify, and what relative priority)
 - Is it possible to schedule, over 2-3 days, the large number of students now assigned to “open reg”

4. Ability for students to request transcripts online – PROD pilot scheduled over the next few weeks; waiting for vendor to complete last set of programming changes

6. Web UI training and practice – roll-out to additional users in July - Link in SIM is <http://ui.gcccd.edu:8084/sim/index.htm>; users have provided some

good feedback; IS continues to update the documentation based on this feedback; need to incorporate use of document imaging

7. Repeat policy – State regulations require that “academic renewal” sections count towards “repeat”; the repeat policies were modified for Fall 2014 registration.
8. DREG – PAY.REMIND wording for students whose only registration activity was to wait list. Here is current wording ... should we revise; i.e. include a “note” about wait-listing?
