1. Summer 2014 Calendar
 - Grades finalized Wednesday, August 6th
 - Beginning the MIS reporting process which will include the Student Success elements (replacing the Matriculation file)

2. Fall 2014 Calendar
 - It was agreed to begin at 8 a.m. for Open Registration. This time (and the associated communication) seemed to work well. There was a system performance issue related to the large number of students accessing WebAdvisor at the same time. For Spring 2015, we will also prioritize and assign a date/time to the students in the Open Reg group. Depending on the number, we will spread over 2-3 days. Last month DIT recommended to sort this group by application term (most current first) and then by application date (oldest date first) which gives priority to new applicants. **Is this still the suggestion?**
 - High School and Middle College Non-Residents – rates were modified for both group to pay non-resident fees.
 - Non-resident tuition rates are now \$193/unit plus the \$46/unit enrollment fee

3. Spring 2015 Calendar
 - Changes for Spring registration include:
 - FYE/FA and Athletes – **how will these students be identified? Is there an attribute that is set or should we just create saved lists for these students? Where in the priority should they be included?**

4. Ability for students to request transcripts online – sent updated term file, “freebie” file and institution file; still trying to identify pilot dates

6. Web UI training and practice – roll-out to additional users in July - Link in SIM is <http://ui.gcccd.edu:8084/sim/index.htm>; users have provided some good feedback; IS continues to update the documentation based on this feedback; need to incorporate use of document imaging

7. Working with Ellucian to identify resources to assist with a software upgrade (releases from April 2013 through August 2014)
