Opportunities - Enrollment Management

- Scheduling/Registration for the whole year supports Strategic Enrollment Management
- Will increase student persistence and completion
- Complements the Promise program to promote full-time attendance
- Supports Guided Pathways program maps

Opportunities - Guaranteed Class Schedule

- We can publish a class schedule and commit to running every section
- Allows students to plan their education with confidence
- Allows adjunct faculty to plan their finances and teaching schedules
- Phenomenal tool for recruiting students and adjunct faculty
- Requires careful planning build small and add sections to meet student demand

Challenges

- Transitioning from 3 semester class schedules to 1 annual class schedule
- Providing priority registration to protected groups who enter the college mid-year
- Scheduling downtime for IT to do maintenance
- Implementing drop for prerequisites throughout the year

Recommendations & Timeline

- Implement for 2021-22
- Fall-Spring-Summer NOT Summer-Fall-Spring
- Plan for extra resources to support Instructional Operations
- Convene the Academic Calendar Committee in spring 2020

Recommendations & Timeline (cont.)

- GB approves 2021-22/2022-23 Academic Calendar by June 2020
- Build Fall 2020 and spring 2021 schedules concurrently
- Begin the 2021-22 class schedule in Flex week 2020
- Publish 2021-22 class schedule on 5/1/21
 - Priority registration on 6/1/21
 - Open registration on 7/1/21
