CCLC Update #42 – Adds exemption for credit ESL

BP 5020 Nonresident Tuition

Reference: Education Code Sections 68050, 68051, 68130, 68130.5,

76140, and 76141; Title 5 Section 54045.5

Adoption Date: July 17, 2012 Revised: July 20, 2021

Nonresident students registering for courses at Grossmont-Cuyamaca Community College District (District) shall be charged nonresident tuition for all units enrolled, unless specifically required otherwise by law.

Not later than March 1 of each year, the Chancellor shall bring to the District Governing Board for approval an action to establish nonresident tuition for the following fiscal year. The fee shall be calculated in accordance with guidelines contained in applicable state regulations and/or the California Community College Attendance Accounting Manual.

The Chancellor shall establish procedures regarding collection, waiver, and refunds of nonresident tuition as outlined in AP 5015 Residence Determination.

Additionally, students who would otherwise be charged nonresident tuition fees for credit English as a Second Language courses shall be exempt if they demonstrate they are a recent immigrant, a recent refugee, or a person who has been granted asylum by the United States. This exemption applies only to individuals who, upon entering the United States, settled in California and who have resided in California for less than one year.
