- If your shower head fills a one-gallon bucket in 20 seconds or less, replace your shower head with a water sense labeled model.

- Glass bottles and containers



Please Keep Out of Recycling Bins:

- Food waste
- Plastic bags and films
- Styrofoam cups and containers

Decomposing Facts that Impact our Environment!

- Aluminum cans = 50 years
- Plastic bottles = 450 years
- Glass bottles = 1 million years
