The Grossmont and Cuyamaca Library Management System, Alma – ExLibris, supports SMS text messages which will notify students of circulation related library information including updates on due dates, holds, and overdue items. To enable this feature, we require assistance from IT in two key areas:

- 1. Integration with the campus's SMS service, Twilio, to facilitate SMS texting within Alma.
- 2. Update the user import profiles originating from Colleague and Workday, which are loaded into Alma daily. Currently, all patron phone numbers are imported as "home" in Alma. To enable text messaging, we will need this updated to "mobile."
